Martin County, FL – The Florida Department of Health in Martin County is offering free STD, HIV and Hepatitis C testing on Friday, August 30 from 1:00 – 4:00 pm at 3441 SE Willoughby Blvd., Stuart. Testing and counseling is offered on a walk-in basis, no appointment is needed.

To prevent the spread of STDs, DOH-Martin provides screening, counseling and treatment for persons infected with or suspected of being infected with STDs. PrEP, a medication regimen that can help lower a person’s risk of contracting HIV, is also available at DOH-Martin.
