(Martin County, FL) – With the start of the new school year just a few weeks away, the Florida Department of Health is urging parents and caregivers to be sure that their student's immunizations are up to date for school entry.

Proof of certain immunizations, on a DH 680 form (Florida Certificate of Immunization), is required for school entry if a child is entering kindergarten, seventh grade or is moving to Florida from another state or country.
